To Whom It May Concern:

Article 4 of DIRECTIVE 2002/95/EC OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 January 2003 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS) States:

"1. Member States shall ensure that, from 1 July 2006, new electrical and electronic equipment put on the market does not contain lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) or polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE). National measures restricting or prohibiting the use of these substances in electrical and electronic equipment which were adopted in line with Community legislation before the adoption of this Directive may be maintained until 1 July 2006."

Based upon a review of our company's product specifications and the specifications reported by our suppliers, to the best of our knowledge, the components or parts supplied by DE-STA-CO do not contain any of the following substances in levels that would violate the "Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 January 2003, on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances (RoHS) in electrical and electronic equipment." Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) or Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PDBE).
